Trietsch Votes to Move Forward with Family Life Center

Lay Leader Suzanne Sutton was so excited by the outcome of the September 11th Charge Conference that she walked around the Ministry Center after it was over saying, "It's a great day in the life of Trietsch."

Trietsch members in attendance voted unanimously to take the next step toward building a Family Life Center on the Dixon Lane property adjacent to the church. Trietsch will now contract with H&H Architects to develop detailed building plans and construction documents.

There were two abstentions in the vote.

Once this step is completed and we've received construction documents and firm construction estimates, Trietsch will have another Charge Conference to approve breaking ground on the project.

Many thanks to the Trietsch Building Committee, who prepared a very detailed presentation about the proposed building.

The proposed building is approximately 32,000 square foot, two-story, multi-use building including:

- A 6,850 s.f. multi-use fellowship area and gymnasium with full-size stage
- A multi-use meeting area on the first floor, dividable to accommodate meetings of up to 250
- Catering kitchen to allow service to 500+ with concession area
- 12 classrooms
- Youth arcade/fellowship area
- Site placement to allow for 2 full sport fields for Upward
- Facility equipped with showers to allow for shelter and overnight purposes
- 6 offices
