## About the Veterans Memorial Plaza

A group of members from Trietsch Memorial United Methodist Church envisioned a place to honor veterans from our community and their loved ones who have served. Our troops, past and present, sacrifice convenience, time, effort and in some cases their lives, so we may live in freedom and democracy. Don't we owe a debt of gratitude to them?

There are numerous monuments for veterans but not a local place of remembrance for those that have touched the lives of our local citizens.

A team was formed and began a fund raising effort to build the Veterans Memorial Plaza. As pictured here, the Memorial is a lasting tribute to veterans' achievements and sacrifice on behalf of our grateful communities.

The center of the Memorial will be graced by a beautiful obelisk surrounded by flags representing the United States, the State of Texas and the Armed Forces.

## How to Help

The war is polarizing our country. Our community needs a place to heal, reflect and give thanks to those who have made the ultimate sacrifice. The Veterans Memorial Plaza allows us to provide the community a setting to honor our active troops and veterans and be a reminder to all that freedom comes with a price. We want to say "Thank You" to our troops for the sacrifices they have made and continue to make on our behalf.

The Veterans Memorial Plaza will be a lasting tribute to our veterans and active troops. All donations are appreciated and the brick campaign will be an ongoing opportunity to allow families, friends and organizations to memorialize their loved ones through a personalized brick in their honor.

There are two main sizes of commemorative bricks, 4"x 8" for \$75 and 8"x 8" for \$200, with or without military logos. Brick prices are set as low as possible so as not to exclude anyone from participating; any amount more that you can pay for a brick and all donations will help underwrite the continuing maintenance costs of the Plaza.
